

**Wary Spar Project Site Plan and Subdivision Review
Applicable Criteria, Performance Standards and Requirements
Rev 1/11/08**

This document attempts to list the applicable criteria, performance standards and requirements of the Town of Long Island Land Use Ordinance that the Planning Board must consider in conducting the site plan and subdivision review for this project. This list of criteria, standards and requirements is neither authoritative nor exhaustive and is merely an attempt by the Planning Board secretary to provide guidance to Board members for their consideration of this matter

Where page numbers are cited in the following they refer to the Town Land Use Ordinance unless otherwise noted.

Item 2. The lot in question, lot #202 on the town assessors map, lies in the IB zone and the proposed use of the structure is an allowed conditional use (3.9.C.12 p27) in this zone, therefore the IB zone district standards are applicable.

Item 3. The lot on which the proposed modified structure will exist, lot #202 of the town assessors map, is in the shoreland zoning district so the shoreland zoning district standards apply.

The lot on which the existing structure that the applicant is proposing to modify is non-conforming as to dimensional requirements (3.9.E p27 and 4.17.M p37) and furthermore, the existing structure that the applicant is proposing to modify is non-conforming as to set-backs and lot coverage (3.9.E. 3,4 p27,28) requirements. Therefore Article 6, Non-conforming Structures, Uses and Lots (p41), is applicable.

Item 5. There is a question as to whether the use of the existing structure constitutes a non-conforming use. It is currently being used as a restaurant, post office and a single family dwelling, all three of which are singly permitted uses in the IB zone (see 3.9.B (1), (2) and (8)). Whether or not the combination of these three uses constitutes a non-conforming use is debatable since the language of the Land Use Ordinance for the IB zone is silent on the issue of combined use. In any event the requirements of Article 6 Section 4, Non-conforming Uses, should probably be addressed.

Item 7. Subdivision approval is required for this project since the division of a structure into three (3) or more dwelling units within a five-year period is considered a subdivision as defined in the definition of Subdivision in Article 11 Section C of the Town's Land Use Ordinance (p74).

The reader will note that many requirements and performance standards listed in Article 11 apply only to subdivisions of land, not structures. However, in these cases it might be prudent for the Board to make note that it finds particular requirements or standards not to be applicable to this project and state the reason for the finding.
